**Exercise 4: Citation Checking**

Then use a citator service (either *Shepard's Citations* in print, *Shepard's* on Lexis, or KeyCite on Westlaw) to determine whether the case has any subsequent history that must be included under ALWD Rule 12.8. Finally, write the citation for the case in ALWD form, including the subsequent history.
